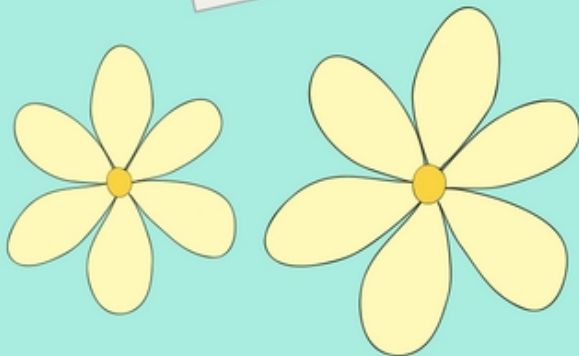


Reunited and it Feels so Good!
